New Tool Designed to Help People Plan for COVID-19 Booster

In collaboration with Cloud 22, the Center for Dignity in Healthcare for People with Disabilities has created a new online widget which generates the date in which a person is eligible to receive their COVID-19 booster vaccine.

Beginning September 20, 2021, it is recommended that people receive a booster vaccine eight months after they have received the second dose of the Pfizer vaccine. It is expected that a booster shot will be available soon for those that received the Moderna vaccine. However, booster shots for the Johnson & Johnson vaccines are not currently available. This tool was created to help people plan for when they will be eligible to receive their COVID Booster vaccine.

“We hope this tool will help people know when they can and should receive a COVID-19 Booster shot to help protect themselves from this virus,” says Dr. Kara Ayers, Director for the Center for Dignity in Healthcare for People with Disabilities. “The tool is helpful for anyone, but we especially hope people with disabilities use it and other resources to get vaccinated.”

The Center for Dignity in Healthcare for People with Disabilities aims to identify and reduce life-limiting healthcare inequities for People with Disabilities. Cloud 22 is for businesses that want more than a web host, they want a partner who supports their growth.
